Heard.

For the reasons stated in the petition, Matrimonial Suit No. 7 of 2013 titled Niraj Gupta Vs. Deepali Gupta pending before the District Court, Alipore, 24-Parganas (S), West Bengal is transferred to Family Court, Bangalore, Karnataka. The transfer petition is allowed accordingly.

At this stage, learned counsel for the respondent-husband submits

that since the respondent shall have to visit Bangalore from Kolkatta for getting his deposition recorded, the petitioner is likely to prolong the proceedings on one pretext or the other only to harass him. He submits that this Court could issue a direction to the transferee court to ensure that recording of the deposition of the respondent as and when the occasion for doing so arises is not unnecessarily delayed.

In the circumstances we make it clear that the trial court would take care that no harassment is caused to either of the parties on account of the opposite party asking for un-necessary adjournments especially when witnesses or the party concerned appears before the court for getting their depositions recorded.
