O R D E R

We find no good ground and reason to interfere with the impugned judgment/order passed by the High Court, denying anticipatory bail to the petitioner, Gulshan @ Gulshan Kumar. However, given the fact that the offences alleged against the petitioner can entail a maximum sentence of upto seven years of imprisonment, we would expect the investigating authorities to be mindful of Sections 35(3) to 35(6) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, and the decision of this court in "*Satender Kumar Antil Vs. Central Bureau of Investigation*"¹.

The special leave petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
