UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. Applications for exemption from filing certified copy of the impugned judgment and exemption from filing official translation are allowed.

2. Permission to file Special Leave Petition is granted.
3. Delay condoned.
4. *Inter alia*, the argument raised by the learned senior counsel for the petitioner is that part of Survey No.64, which was purchased by him vide sale deed dated 4<sup>th</sup> January, 2001, has been added in the list of properties to be partitioned by the family members basing their claim on an agreement to sale executed in favour of some of the family members dated 12<sup>th</sup> September, 1980. It was further argued that after the sale deed was executed, the possession of the property was handed over to the petitioner and he is still in possession.
5. Issue notice.
6. Mr. Kanu Agarwal and Mr. Krishna Dev Jagarlamudi, learned counsel accept notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 and 3, respectively.
7. Let notices be issued to the other respondents for 24<sup>th</sup> July, 2026.
8. In the meantime, *status quo* regarding possession of the property in dispute as referred to above, shall be maintained by the parties and any further proceedings in the partition suit shall be subject to the final disposal of the present petition.
