3. Mr. Shrirang B. Varma, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of the State of Maharashtra. Service of formal notice on the respondent-State of

Maharashtra stands dispensed with.

4. Respondent- State of Maharashtra may file its counter affidavit within two weeks. Such affidavit ought to include, *inter alia*, the following particulars:

(i) chargesheet, if filed;

(ii) number of witnesses proposed to be examined by the prosecution;

(iii) whether charge is framed or not;

(iv) if the charge has not been framed, the reason therefor;

(v) if the trial has commenced, the number of witnesses examined;

(vi) criminal antecedents of the petitioner;

(vii) whether any co-accused is enlarged on bail; and

(viii) any other information relevant for a decision on the special leave petition.

5. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within a week thereafter.
