UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Heard Mr. Jay Savla, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr. Siddharth Dharmadhikari, learned standing counsel appearing on advance notice for the respondent No.5-State of Maharashtra.

2. Learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that they have in turn allotted the land to respondent No.7-M/s Nobel Explochem Limited and respondent No.8-IPCA Laboratory Limited.

3. Learned senior counsel also placed before us a clause in the interse deed between his client and M/s Nobel Explochem Limited and IPCA Laboratory Limited to the effect that for any enhancement in compensation M/s. Nobel Explochem Limited and IPCA Laboratory Limited will be responsible. If there are any interse arrangement between the petitioner-State Industrial and Investment Corporation of Maharashtra and M/s. Nobel Explochem Limited and IPCA Laboratory Limited that cannot operate to the prejudice of the land-losers who have not received even the enhanced compensation as enhanced by the Reference Court. The impugned order fixes joint responsibility on the petitioner, M/s. Nobel Explochem Limited, IPCA Laboratory Limited and the State for the disbursal of compensation.

4. Having considered the submissions and perused the records, we are not inclined to interfere with the impugned order.

5. However, if the petitioner has any right against M/s. Nobel Explochem Limited and IPCA Laboratory Limited and any other authority, they are left to pursue remedies against them. We repeat that as far as land-losers are concerned, the petitioner, M/s. Nobel Explochem Limited, IPCA Laboratory Limited and the State will all be jointly and severally responsible and the enhanced compensation, if not being paid, should be disbursed immediately.

6. With the above observations, the Special Leave Petition is disposed of.

7. Pending applications shall also stand disposed of.
