O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
3. The civil appeal was disposed of by order dated 02.09.2025.
4. The wife has moved an application seeking clarification/modification of the order, insofar as the picking and dropping of the child by her is concerned.
5. In the facts and circumstances of the case, we are not inclined to grant any such clarification or modification.
6. However, as the learned counsel for the husband submits that he is ready to reimburse the travelling expenses of the wife incurred in picking and dropping the child, he may, as suggested, pay a sum of Rs.25,000/- per month to the wife as travelling expenses for the picking and dropping of the child.

7. The travelling expenses for the month of April, 2026 shall be paid/deposited by the last date of the month and for each succeeding month, by the 10<sup>th</sup> of every month.

8. It is clarified that the picking and dropping of the child shall be in accordance with the school timings, which may change every season and may not strictly be treated as 04:00 PM, as mentioned in the order dated 02.09.2025.

9. Accordingly, the clarification/modification application stands disposed of.

10. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
