O R D E R

1. Exemption Application is allowed.

2. The petitioner (Original Complainant) is aggrieved by the Order passed by the High Court dated 27-1-2026 by which the High Court in a petition preferred by the Original Accused persons for quashing of criminal proceedings has granted interim relief and has stayed the criminal proceedings till further orders.

3. We are of the view that since the matter is at large before the High Court, let the matter be heard by the High Court at the earliest, more particularly when the proceedings of the criminal case have been stayed by the High Court.

4. We are informed that no particular date has been fixed by the High Court for further hearing of the matter.

5. In such circumstances, it shall be open for the petitioner to make a request to the High Court to fix one particular date and hear the matter finally.

6. With the aforesaid, the petition stands disposed of.
