O R D E R

Special leave petition is wholly misconceived and frivolous. We thought of dismissing the matter with costs of Rs. 10,000/- as there is absolutely no justification for the petitioner to approach this Court when the Writ Petition filed by the respondent herein against the petitioner was withdrawn by the respondent and the High Court, despite the fact that respondent had made prayer for withdrawal of the Writ Petition, imposed cost of Rs. 10,000/- on the present respondent (writ petitioner therein). With such a just order in favour of the petitioner, he has yet chosen to approach this Court with absolutely no cause of action and no grievance at all. Cost of Rs. 10,000/- would have been a little deterrent, but since the advocate-on-record for the petitioner is a young lawyer, we do not impose the cost.
