O R D E R

1. Ms. Arundhati Katju, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner, draws the attention of this Court to paragraphs 10 and 13 of the order dated 09.01.2025 passed in

FAO No. 6017 of 2025 (page 2,3 and 5 of the paperbook) to contend that since the Arbitrator was the Director Industries, Chandigarh Administration, the proceedings are vitiated.

2. Learned senior advocate draws the attention of this Court to the judgment of this Court in *Bhadra International (India) Pvt. Ltd. and Others vs. Airports Authority of India, reported in 2026 SCC Online SC 7 para 123* to contend that the finding of the High Court that since the proceedings were completed, the petitioner cannot allege ineligibility, is clearly wrong.

3. List this matter on 18.05.2026.

4. In the meantime, *status quo*, as of today, with regard to all the matters, shall be maintained.
