O R D E R

1. The petitioner challenges the judgment and order dated 22-09-2025 in CRMN No. 65921/2025 passed by the High Court of Judicature at Patna.

2. Delay condoned.
3. Issue notice, returnable on 24.04.2026.
4. Mr. Manish Kumar, Advocate-on-Record accepts notice on behalf of the State of Bihar. Hence, the formal service of notice on the respondent-State is waived.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner to serve a copy of the present petition to the learned counsel for the respondent-State within a period of one week.
6. Let counter affidavit be filed within two weeks. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within one week thereafter.
7. In the event of arrest in connection with FIR No. 270 of 2025, registered at P.S. Sahebganj, District-Muzaffarpur, the petitioner shall be released on bail by the Investigating/Arresting Officer on such terms and conditions as imposed and found to be just, fair and reasonable.
8. The petitioner shall make himself available before the Investigating Officer on 25.03.2026 at 10:00 a.m. and on all such dates as he may be required.
9. Needless to add, the petitioner would maintain good conduct and not attempt to influence any of the witnesses, in any manner, till the completion of the trial.
