Mr. K.K. Venugopal, learned Senior Advocate, on instructions, submits that a Commission of Inquiry has been appointed vide a Notification dated 16th November, 2000 after the impugned order of the High Court dated 24th April, 2000 and that Commission of Inquiry was given six months time to submit its report. However, it has made no progress because even the office has not been set up and this delay would be prejudicial to enquire into the subject matter which is of serious concern as it involves security of the State.
