Learned Counsel for the petitioner contends that the landlord sold some other premises belonging to him during the pendency of the proceeding in which he was himself residing. We find from the judgement of the High Court that the landlord was compelled to sell the premises with a view to arrange for funds for the marriage of his daughter which was a compelling necessity.
