O R D E R

We find no ground to interfere under Art.136 the Constitution of India particularly as the High Court has directed that suit should be decided within one year from the date of its order and nearly four months have elapsed. SLP is therefore dismissed.

However, the dismissal of this petition will not come in the way of the petitioner making an application before the Trial Court under Section 52 of the Transfer of Property Act, for releasing the suit property from the operation of Sec.52 of Transfer of Property Act.
