Heard.

We do not see any reason to interfere with the impugned order. The  
Special Leave Petition is accordingly dismissed.

We, however, permit the petitioners to file an application for  
grant of regular bail before the competent court after surrendering  
before the said court. If an application is indeed filed, the  
competent court shall dispose of the same as expeditiously as possible  
but not later than four weeks from the date the application is filed.

For a period of six weeks, the petitioners shall remain protected  
against arrest. We make it clear that while disposing of the  
application for grant of regular bail, the court concerned shall  
remain uninfluenced by the fact that we have granted interim  
protection to the petitioners no matter for a limited period.
