O R D E R

1. Heard Mr. Challakodanda Ram, learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioner. The impugned order is an order where it remands the matter back to the Andhra Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (for short, 'the Commission') for deciding the issue of the claim of interest. Learned Senior Counsel submits that the issue is already concluded by the order dated 22.06.2013 issued by the Commission.

2. Needless to observe that when the Commission on remand considers the matter, all aspects of the matter including the applicability of the order of 22.06.2013 will be looked into and the application for payment of interest will be adjudicated after hearing all the concerned parties.
