The matter above mentioned was listed before the Hon'ble Court on 9<sup>th</sup> July, 2012 when the Court was pleased to pass the following order:

"Ms.Kamini Jaiswal, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the Special Leave Petition with liberty to file an appropriate application before the High Court. Permission sought for is granted and the Special Leave Petition is disposed of as withdrawn. We direct the petitioner to file an appropriate application before the High Court itself for disposal of Civil Misc. (Criminal nature) Writ Petition No.2766 of 2007 within two weeks' time from today. If such an application is filed, we request the High Court to consider the said application and dispose of the said application on merits as expeditiously as possible at any rate within six months from today. If, for any reason, the said application is not disposed of within six months' time from today, the petitioner is at liberty to make an appropriate application to revive the Special Leave Petition.

Ordered accordingly."
