UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner invites our attention to the order dated 09.01.2026 passed by the High Court of Punjab and Haryana at Chandigarh in CRM-M-203-2026 whereby, the co-accused, being the main assailant, has already been enlarged on anticipatory bail.
2. The petitioner challenges the judgment and order dated 03-02-2026 in CRM-M-4638-2026 (O&M) passed by the High Court of Punjab and Haryana at Chandigarh.
3. Issue notice, returnable on 08.05.2026.
4. Mr. Karan Sharma, Advocate-on-Record accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab. Hence, the formal service of notice on the respondent-State is waived.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner to serve a copy of the present petition to the learned counsel for the respondent-State within a period of one week.
6. Let counter affidavit be filed within two weeks. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within one week thereafter.
7. In the event of arrest in connection with F.I.R. No.178/2025 dated 08.11.2025, registered at P.S. Ramdas, District-Amritsar, Punjab, the petitioner shall be released on bail by the Investigating/Arresting Officer on such terms and conditions as imposed and found to be just, fair and reasonable.
8. The petitioner shall make himself available before the Investigating Officer on 10.04.2026 at 10:00 a.m. and on all

such dates as he may be required.

9. Needless to add, the petitioner would maintain good conduct and not attempt to influence any of the witnesses, in any manner, till the completion of the trial.
