O R D E R

1. The petitioner challenges the judgment and order dated 10.03.2026 in Criminal Appeal No.8643 of 2025, titled "*Jyoti Mishra Vs. State of U.P. & Anr.*", passed by the High Court of Judicature at Allahabad.
2. We have heard learned counsel for the petitioner(s).
3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the

private respondent has two antecedents, more or less of similar nature and that she has been declared a proclaimed offender, as is evident from document at Annexure P-10 (page No. 58).
