



petitions disclose the name of the village, survey numbers, extent or other particulars of the land acquired. In short, it is impossible to ascertain from the SLPs as to which land the matter relates to.

Page E of the memo of dates wrongly gives the date of preliminary notification as 23.2.2003, whereas at Page F of the memo of dates, the reference Court judgment produced by the petitioner show the date of preliminary notifications as 4.3.1993, 13.5.1993 and 21.6.1995. The memo of dates requires to be rectified and the particulars of lands to which the SLPs relate, are to be disclosed. Even though we had pointed out such errors in regard to other SLPs filed in regard to the said acquisition, the errors are repeated and at all events not corrected. Therefore, finally, four weeks' time is granted to the petitioner to rectify the mistakes subject to deposit of Rs.2500/- as costs with the Supreme Court

Legal Services Committee within four weeks.

The special leave petitions are filed in regard to the same acquisition in trickles, after a long delay. As the decision has been taken by the appellant to file SLPs in regard to entire acquisition of lands for Electrical Warfare Range, there is no reason why all the SLPs could not be filed together. The petitioner cannot go on filing the matters with delays ranging from 9 to 12 months without proper explanation. If similar SLPs are pending, the petitioner should request the Registry to list them together.

List all the connected cases in the last week of January 2011. In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to file within six weeks showing the following:

- (I) A consolidated statement showing:
  - (i) The case number;
  - (ii) Particulars of the lands acquired, that is,

village, extent, survey nos. etc.;

(iii) Date of preliminary notification; and

(iv) Amount awarded by the Land Acquisition Officer,  
the Reference Court and the High Court in each case.

(II) A map showing the situation of the lands.
