This petition is filed by the wife seeking transfer
of the petition filed by the husband under Section 10 of

Guardians & Wards Act for obtaining guardianship of son, from the 2nd Principal Judge, Family Court at Jabalpur to the Court of District Judge, Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi. The petitioner alleges that she is residing with her minor son and ailing parents in her parents' house at Delhi; that she will not be able to bear the expenses and travel alone to Jabalpur to contest the case as there is nobody to accompany her. Respondent though served has not entered appearance.

2. On the facts and circumstances of the case, we consider this a fit case for transfer.

3. Accordingly Transfer Petition is allowed and Petition No.3/2011 titled as "Dara Singh Maggo vs. Gunjan Singh @ Dolly & Ors." pending on the file of 2nd Principal Judge, Family Court, Jabalpur is ordered to be transferred to the District Judge, Tis Hazari Court, Delhi, who may assign it to appropriate court/Family Court for disposal.
