Leave granted.

Appellant is aggrieved by order dated 25.4.2012 passed by learned Single Judge of Punjab and Haryana High Court at Chandigarh, whereby the appellant's application under Section 438, Code of Criminal Procedure, for her anticipatory bail in a case registered by way of F.I.R. No.58 dated 4.4.2012 at Police Station Sadar, Gohana, District Sonapat for offence punishable under Sections 323, 406 and 498-A, Indian Penal Code, has been dismissed.

After having heard learned counsel for the Appellant and after perusal of the record, we deem it fit and proper to grant protection to the Appellant for a period of 30 days. In the event of arrest, Appellant- Madhu Bala be released on bail on her furnishing bail bond and solvent surety to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.

For the aforesaid period of 30 days, Appellant - Madhu Bala shall not be arrested in the aforesaid case. But within this period, she would apply before the competent Criminal Court for regular bail, which may be considered by the concerned Court on merits, in accordance with law, preferably on the same date, provided advance copy is served on the Public Prosecutor.

With the aforesaid directions, Appeal stands disposed of.
