O R D E R

1. The petitioner challenges the judgment and order dated 09.03.2026 in CRLMC No. 1652/2026 titled "*Jitendra Tiwari vs. State of NCT of Delhi & Anr.*" passed by the High Court of Delhi at New Delhi.
