since more than 30 years therefore in any case sufficient time may be given to them for vacating the same. On this ground, we have heard the learned counsel for the respondents. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, particularly the stand taken by the Corporation for disposal of quarters in favour of its employees who are occupying the same as prayed for,

time to vacate is granted till the end of the academic year 2001, i.e. upto 30th April, 2000 on their furnishing the usual undertaking to hand over peacefully and vacant possession of the premises on or before the said date and to pay regularly the license fee as payable by the employees of the Corporation (not market or penal rent). However, this benefit would be given to those petitioners who file usual undertaking to vacate the premises to the Municipal Commissioner or the Delhi Jal Board within four weeks from today.
