The writ petition filed by the petitioner for stalling the elections held for Municipal Corporation, Gurgaon, was dismissed by the Division Bench of the High Court on the ground of availability of alternative remedy.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, we are convinced that the High Court rightly refused to entertain the petitioner's challenge to the electoral roll.

In view of the bar contained in Article 243ZG, the High Court could not have entertained the petitioner's prayer

and that too by ignoring the law laid down in N.P.
