1. In these petitions, prayer has been made for review of order dated 25.08.2010 passed in 24753, 24781, 24776, 24809, 24800, 24765, 24773 & 24801-24808 of 2010.

2. The petitioner has also filed an application for condonation of 231 days' delay in filing the review petitions. We have

perused the averments contained in the application for condonation of delay and are convinced that the explanation given by the petitioner is wholly unsatisfactory.
