O R D E R

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that although the allegation in the FIR alleges that the petitioner had taken ₹22,50,000/- (Rupees Twenty Two Lakhs Fifty Thousands Only) from the complainant, however, the truth of the matter is that the petitioner has only received ₹10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs Only), which he is ready to return.
2. Let complainant be impleaded as respondent.
3. Memo of parties be corrected.

4. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable on 25.05.2026.
5. The petitioner shall return the amount of ₹10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs Only) to the complainant within two weeks and submit receipt of such payment to the complainant.
6. In the meanwhile, the petitioner shall not be arrested in relation to FIR No.666 dated 15.11.2025, registered at Industrial Sector-29, Panipat, Haryana under Sections 316(2), 318(4) BNS, 2023 and Section 24 of Immigration Act, 1983, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall continue to co-operate with the investigation/trial and shall appear as and when called upon to do so.
