O R D E R

Having gone through the impugned order, we find no ground to interfere under Article 136 of the Constitution of India. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for grant of regular bail within a period of 10 days hereof. On such an application being filed and an advance copy be served on the Government Pleader, so as to enable him to secure the case diary, the learned trial Judge would thereafter endeavour to consider the petitioner's application for bail on merits and in accordance with law. For a period of 10 days, the petitioner shall not be arrested.

With the aforesaid direction, the special leave petition stands disposed of.
