This is an application by the petitioner for extension of the
time specified in the Court's order dated 24.05.2010.

Having perused the averments contained in the application, we
do not find any justification to entertain the petitioner's prayer
for grant of six months' further time to vacate the suit premises
and direct him to hand over vacant possession of the premises to
the respondent on or before 31.03.2011.

If the petitioner fails to vacate the premises and hand over
possession, the Executing Court shall, on an application made by

the landlord, direct use of force for ensuring that the decree
passed by the trial Court is executed. The concerned Court shall
not entertain any application by the petitioner or for that reason
by any other person which may obstruct implementation of this
order.

With the above observation, the application is disposed of.
