These petitions are directed against orders dated 29.12.2010 and 30.11.2009 passed by the Division Bench of the Himachal Pradesh High Court, whereby the writ petition preferred by the respondents was allowed in terms of order

dated 24.4.2009 passed in CWP(T) No.3420 of 2008 and the petition filed for review of the first order was dismissed.

We have heard learned counsel for the petitioners for some time and carefully gone through the order passed in CWP(T) No.3420 of 2008.

In our view, the detailed reasons assigned by the

learned Single Judge for directing the petitioners to pay salary in the scale of Rs.3120-6200 which is prescribed for the Cooks employed in other departments are legally correct and the orders under challenge do not call for interference under Article 136 of the Constitution.

The special leave petitions are accordingly dismissed.
