Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that the High Court has misconstrued the decision of the Constitution Bench of this Court, as the firm powers under Article 227 of the Constitution of India which is one of the superintendence is very much available to the High Court.

We are not inclined to go into the other issues raised before us, both on fact and law.

What the petitioner seeks is an early hearing of the Suit No.158 of 2020, pending before the Court of the Civil Judge (Senior Division)-Hamirpur for the last six years.

Considering the urgency expressed before us, we direct the Civil Judge (Senior Division)-Hamirpur to make an endeavour to dispose of the aforesaid suit expeditiously, and if possible, within a period of one year, in accordance with law.

The Special Leave Petition is disposed of, accordingly.

Pending applications shall also stand disposed of.
