O R D E R

Mr. Colin Gonsalves, senior advocate
appearing for the respondent states that each of
the 82 workmen shall give an undertaking in
writing to the petitioner-Management that in case
their complaint pending before the Industrial
Court is finally dismissed, the petitioner would
be entitled to recover the respective amounts paid
to them in terms of the interim order of the High
Court from their terminal dues or their future
wages, as the case may be.

In view of that undertaking, we see no
reason to interfere with the order passed by the
High Court, more so as it is an interim order.
