UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

This petition is directed against the order  
of the learned Single Judge of Allahabad High  
Court who declined to interfere with the order  
passed by Tehsildar, Sadar Pilibhit under Section  
122B of the U.P.Z.A. and L.R. Act, 1950.

We have heard Shri K.B. Sinha, learned  
senior counsel for the petitioners and perused the  
record.            Since the impugned order was passed in

terms of the statement made by the learned counsel  
appearing before the High Court, we do not find

any valid ground or justification to entertain

this special leave petition,            which is,  
accordingly, dismissed.

However, keeping in view the nature of the  
case, we direct the Revisional Authority to

dispose of the revision petitions which may have been filed by them and other similarly situated persons or which may be filed in next two weeks within a period of three months from the date of communication of this order.

We further direct that till the decision of the revision petition, status quo shall be maintained regarding possession of the petitioners.

It shall be duty of the petitioners to communicate this order to the Revisional Authority and also file revision petition(s) within a period of seven days from today, in case they have already not filed such petition(s). Order may be given dasti.
