O R D E R

Heard Mr. Shoeb Alam, learned senior counsel for the petitioner.

2. It was submitted that though the impugned judgment *per se* is not being challenged by the petitioner as it is a case where the High Court has remanded the matter to the Family Court for fresh consideration, but he has apprehension with regard to the

misrepresentation of the order dated 30.10.2025 passed by the High Court of Madras at Madurai Bench in CMA(MD) No.1158 of 2023, relating to the interim arrangement made by the High Court at the relevant point of time, especially when the matter has now been disposed of by the High Court. It was submitted that by order dated 30.10.2025 passed by the High Court in CMA(MD) No.1158 of 2023, as an interim arrangement, the respondent-wife was given liberty to stay in the same premises where the child was residing till the disposal of the appeal. However, despite the appeal being now disposed of, the respondent-wife is not vacating the residence and thus, the petitioner be given liberty to withdraw the present petition with liberty to move before the High Court seeking clarification of the order dated 30.10.2025.

3. Having considered the matter, we find the prayer to be *bonafide*.

4. Accordingly, the present Special Leave Petitions stand disposed of with liberty aforesaid.

5. We make it clear that we have not expressed any opinion on the merits of the matter.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
