UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

After having heard learned counsel for the
petitioner and after perusing the impugned order and
the record we find that there is no substance in the
petition. It is accordingly dismissed.

However, learned counsel prayed that the
petitioner may be granted nine months time to vacate
the premises in question. Thus without considering the
merits of the matter we deem it fit and proper to grant

nine months time to the petitioner to vacate the
premises in question and hand over peaceful and vacant

possession to respondent Nos. 1 to 21. The petitioner

would also furnish an undertaking in the form of an
affidavit to this Court within a period of one month
from today mentioning therein that he shall handover
peaceful and vacant possession to the respondent Nos. 1
to 21 within a period of nine months from today and
would also pay the arrears of rent, if any, and would

continue to pay monthly rent by 15th of each month,
failing thereof, the respondent-decree-holders will be
at liberty to execute the decree forthwith.

The special leave petition is disposed of
accordingly.
