O R D E R

Delay condoned.

We are not inclined to accept the prayer made in the miscellaneous application for reduction of the amount of permanent alimony as recorded in paragraph 8 of the judgment and order dated 27th November, 2025. However, we are inclined to consider the request for enlargement of time granted in the aforesaid order.

According to learned counsel for the applicant, an amount of Rs. 15,00,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Lakhs only) was paid on 1st January, 2026. Thus, even the first installment of Rs.25,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Lakhs only) has not been fully paid, though the time allowed for the second installment has also expired.

However, since we are inclined to consider the prayer for enlargement of time, we direct the matter be listed on 18th May, 2026.

By the said date, the applicant shall pay the remaining amount of Rs. 10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakh only) towards the first installment. If the said amount is paid, the request for enlargement of time for the second installment will be considered.
