UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. The petitioner challenges the judgment and order dated 09-01-2026 in CRM No. 84122/2025 passed by the High Court of Judicature at Patna titled "*Satyam Saurav vs. The State of Bihar*".

2. We have heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner as well as learned counsel appearing for the respondent-State.

3. Issue notice, returnable on 11th May, 2026.
4. Mr. Samir Ali Khan, Advocate-on-Record, accepts notice on behalf of the State of Bihar. Hence, the formal service of notice on the respondent-State is waived.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner to serve a copy of the present petition to the learned counsel for the respondent-State within a period of one week.
6. Let counter affidavit be filed within two weeks. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within one week thereafter.
7. We make it clear that no further opportunity will be granted for this purpose.
8. In the event of arrest in connection with Cyber case being FIR No.92/2025 dated 15.06.2025, registered at Motihari Cyber Police Station, East Champaran, Motihari, Bihar, the petitioner shall be released on bail by the Investigating/Arresting Officer on such terms and conditions as imposed and found to be just, fair and reasonable.
9. The petitioner shall make himself available before the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer on 27.04.2026 at 10:00 a.m. and on all such dates as may be required.
10. Needless to add, the petitioner would maintain good conduct and will not attempt to influence any of the witnesses, in any manner, till the completion of the trial.
