**UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R**

1. Permission to file special leave petition(s) is granted.
2. Delay condoned.
3. The High Court of Madhya Pradesh by the order impugned has spurned the challenge of the petitioners (guest faculties) to certain eligibility clauses for appointment as Professors framed by the State Government.
4. Having heard Mr. Nikhil Nayyar, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioners and in view of the limited nature of relief claimed in the special leave petitions, we grant liberty to the petitioners to approach the Higher Education Department of the Government of Madhya Pradesh for extending the benefit of age relaxation and reservation. After all, it is a policy decision which has to be taken at the governmental level and it may not be prudent on the part of the Court to re-write the clauses relating to eligibility.
5. If any approach is made by the petitioners, we have no doubt in our mind that the government at the appropriate level shall consider and decide the same at an early date.
6. With the aforesaid liberty/observation and without disturbing the impugned order, the special leave petitions stand disposed of.
7. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
