O R D E R

These petitions are directed against the judgments of the Division Bench of the Allahabad High Court which declined to interfere with the award passed by the Reference Court for enhancement of the compensation payable to the respondents in lieu of their land which was acquired by the petitioner for Kanpur Bhoomi Vikas Yojna No.2.

We have heard Shri Vishwajit Singh, learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record. Learned counsel fairly stated that similar petitions filed by the petitioner have already been dismissed.

Dehors the statement of the learned counsel, we have carefully examined the record of the case and are convinced that the Reference Court did not commit any error by enhancing the compensation payable to the respondents and the High Court rightly refused to interfere with the award of the Reference Court.

The special leave petitions are accordingly dismissed.
