This petition is filed by the petitioner wife praying for transfer of the case being H.M.O.P No. 614 of 2010 titled K.

Shailendra Kumar Jaiswal @ Bablu Vs. Sharda Jaiswal @ Babli Jaiswal from the Family Court at Madurai(Tamil Nadu) to a competent court at Howrah (West Bengal).

The parties hereto were married according to the Hindu Marriage Act. However, matrimonial disputes have arisen between the parties consequent upon which the petitioner herein has filed two cases against the respondent which are pending in Howrah,
