

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that on account of busy transaction he has suffered huge losses. Thus, he has not been able to pay the price of the diamonds to the complainant.

Be that as it may. We do not find any ground to interfere against the impugned order passed by the learned single Judge. However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to move an application for grant of regular bail to him. On such an application being filed and if an advance copy thereof is served to the Government Pleader, then an endeavour would be made by the learned trial Judge to hear and dispose of the same as expeditiously as may be possible.

This petition stands disposed of.
