



1. Against an order rejecting the regular bail by the High Court and to seek bail, the present special leave petition has been filed.

2. The petitioner is in custody w.e.f. 04.12.2025 in connection with FIR No.253/2025 dated 04.12.2025 for the offences punishable under Sections 8/15 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act registered with Police Station Tehla, District Alwar, Rajasthan.

3. It is seen that the bail petition was dismissed mainly on the ground that despite release of the petitioner in the previous case with a condition not to indulge in similar offence, he has been found indulged in this case. It is true that condition of the bail ought to be complied with by the

petitioner but the breakthrough is that the co-accused having an identical case has been released on bail by the High Court merely serving a period of six weeks. The custody of the petitioner is more than five months. Considering the said appealing situation, we deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on bail.

4. Accordingly, we direct that the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing the suitable bail bonds and sureties and on such other terms and conditions as may be deemed fit by the trial Court.

5. Petitioner to abide all the conditions as imposed and shall regularly attend the trial until exempted by the Court. It is hereby made clear that in case the

appellant is found indulged in any other case of similar nature, the State would be at liberty to apply for cancellation of the bail. Violation, if any, of any other condition may also give a cause to take recourse as permissible and the trial Court is at liberty to do the needful.

6. Accordingly and in view of the foregoing, the special leave petition stands allowed.

7. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
