This petition is directed against the judgment of the learned Single Judge of the Punjab and Haryana High Court, who refused to upset the well reasoned judgments of the two courts in a suit filed by the petitioners for declaring Will dated 30.11.1993 executed by Smt. Surji Devi in favour of respondent No.1 as illegal, null and void-ab-initio and dismissed the second appeal preferred by the petitioners.
