**UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R**

1. Delay condoned.
2. Since the certificate of disability (appearing at page 57 of the special leave petition) relied on by the petitioner was not placed on record before the High Court and, hence, it had no occasion to consider the same, we see no reason to interfere with the impugned judgment and order of the High Court dated 20th February, 2025.
3. However, since it is the petitioner's claim that the certificate of disability could not be placed on record before the High Court for reasons

beyond her control, we grant her liberty to apply for a review of the impugned judgment and order within a fortnight from date.

4. In the event the petitioner applies for review within a fortnight from date, such application shall be considered on its own merits without limitation creating a bar.

5. We also clarify that should the review application fail, the petitioner shall be at liberty to challenge the impugned judgment and order of the High Court afresh.

6. The special leave petition stands disposed of, on the above terms.

7. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
