UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

This petition is directed against judgment
dated 21.3.2007 of the Division Bench of
Karnataka High Court in Writ Appeal No.1656 of
2006 and order dated 10.3.2010 passed in Review
Petition No. 232 of 2008. The petitioner has
also filed an application for condonation of 1072
days delay.

We have heard learned counsel for the
petitioner and perused the record including the
application for condonation of delay. In our
view, the explanation given by the petitioner for
not filing the special leave petition within the
prescribed period of limitation is wholly
unsatisfactory. The fact that the petitioner was
pursuing the remedy of review cannot justify
condonation of the delay of more than three years
because the review petition was filed after one
year and three months of the dismissal of the
writ appeal.

For the reasons stated above, the
petitioner's prayer for condonation of delay is
rejected and the special leave petition is
dismissed as barred by time.
