O R D E R

By the impugned order the High Court has refused to initiate contempt proceedings. That was within the discretion and jurisdiction of the High Court and cannot be said to have been exercised unreasonably. Any other right which the petitioner has, he is at liberty to pursue and seek before an appropriate forum in duly constituted legal proceedings wherein the impugned order does not come in the way.
