O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. We are not inclined to interfere with the impugned judgment and order of the High Court; hence, the special leave petition is dismissed.
3. It appears that the petitioners have been behind bars for more than 19

years with remission. In view thereof, the Superintendent of the Correctional Home where the petitioners are lodged shall move the appropriate Department in the Government of Uttar Pradesh for securing their pre-mature release subject, of course, to the petitioners being otherwise eligible therefor in terms of the extant remission policy of the State. An appropriate decision shall be taken by the State without any delay, once the Superintendent moves on behalf of the petitioners for securing such release.
