restraint order was in operation and as to when the alienation has taken place which constituted the violation are relevant questions for consideration. In this case we find it is not here. Accordingly the impugned order is not sustainable and is hereby quashed. The impugned order is set aside. The matter is sent back to the High Court for disposing

of the same afresh after notice to the parties. The matter may be disposed of within eight weeks from the date of the receipt of the copy of this order by the High Court.
