O R D E R

1. Applications for exemption from filing certified copy of the impugned judgment and exemption from filing official translation are allowed.
2. Heard Ms. Vandana Sehgal, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.
3. Delay condoned.

4. Learned counsel, at the outset, submits that against the order dismissing the Revision Petition also a Special Leave Petition has been filed under Diary No.17208 of 2026.

5. Insofar as the present petition is concerned, learned counsel draws attention of the Court to page 79 of the paperbook (pdf 94) wherein pending the Revision Petition, the High Court by order dated 18th February, 2020 permitted the petitioner to surrender before the Trial Court and furnish bail bonds as directed in the order. Learned counsel further draws attention to page 80 (pdf 95) of the paperbook to demonstrate that the bail bonds were duly furnished on 25th February, 2020 and the petitioner was on bail pending the Revision Petition.

6. Learned counsel submits that the impugned order by recording that the petitioner was not present in the High Court on one occasion as directed, for which too he had an explanation to offer, the bail bonds have been cancelled and the Revision Petition dismissed by the High Court.

7. Issue notice, returnable on 18th May, 2026.

8. Dasti service, in addition, is permitted.

9. Till further orders, there shall be stay of operation of the impugned order.
