UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. The petitioner challenges the judgment and order dated 09.01.2026 in RCREV No.252/2023 titled "*Anil Kumar Jain vs. Subhash Chand Chawla alias Subhash Chander Chawla*" passed by the High Court of Delhi at New Delhi.
2. Issue notice, returnable on 28.05.2026.
3. Ms. Shriya Maini, learned Advocate-on-Record accepts notice on behalf of the respondent. Hence, service of formal

notice is waived.

4. Let counter affidavit be filed within two weeks. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within two weeks thereafter.

5. Heard learned counsel for the parties. The submissions would reveal the desire of the parties to explore the possibility of a mediated settlement.

6. In such circumstances, we request and appoint Mr.Sudhanshu Dhulia, former Judge of the Supreme Court of India, as the Mediator in helping the parties to arrive at an amicable settlement.

7. The parties are directed to appear before the Mediator on the date, time and place as may be fixed by the learned Mediator.

8. List the matter along with Mediation Report on 28.05.2026.

9. The Registry shall forthwith communicate a copy of this order to all concerned.

10. In the meanwhile, the operation, execution and implementation of the judgment and final order dated 09.01.2026 passed by the High Court of Delhi at New Delhi in RC Rev. 252/2023 shall remain stayed.
