O R D E R

These petitions are directed against order dated 30.4.2013 passed by the learned Single Judge of the Andhra Pradesh High Court whereby he dismissed the revisions filed by the petitioners and confirmed order dated 30.08.2012 passed by VII Additional District Judge, Mahabubnagar.

We have heard Shri L.Nageswara Rao, learned senior counsel for the petitioners and Shri K.V.Vishwanathan, learned senior counsel for respondent No.1, who has entered caveat and is the only contesting respondent.

In our opinion, the order passed by the trial Court was based on correct analysis of the pleadings and documents produced by the parties and the High Court did not commit any error by dismissing the revision petitions.

The special leave petitions are accordingly dismissed.

However, it is made clear that the observation contained in paragraph 14 of the order passed by the trial Court shall not operate as a bar to the petitioners' participation in the future elections.
